

Krijgt u bij het openen van het Programma Clubmatch in Windows 10 de foutmelding:

Error 339

MScomctl.ocx or one of its dependencies not correctly registered: a file is missing or invalid.

In source: ClubmatchXP

In mod Clubmatch: Main

Dan betekent dit dat het bestand Comcdl.ocx niet geïnstalleerd en/of niet geregistreerd is, dit is een Activex bestand.

Om dit op te lossen volgt u onder staande handleiding.

Comcdl32.ocx is a Visual Basic 6.0 runtime file that's not included in Windows 10. The Clubmatch program which was presumably developed using VB 6.0 needs to supply the required runtime libraries.

However, you may try the Visual Basic 6.0 Common Controls (includes comcdl32.ocx) from the following Microsoft Download Center

**Don't** run the setup. Instead, open the exe file using 7-Zip or any other archiving utility and extract the file Comcdl32.OCX file to the following folder:

### **Copying the OCX file:**

For Windows 64-bit systems, extract the OCX file to:  
C:\Windows\SysWOW64

For Windows 32-bit systems, extract the OCX file to:  
C:\Windows\System32

### **Register the OCX file:**

Right-click Start, click [Powershell \(Admin\)](#)

If you're using **Windows 32-bit**, type the following command and press ENTER:

```
regsvr32 comdlg32.ocx
```

If you're using **Windows 64-bit**, type the following command and press ENTER:

```
C:\Windows\SysWOW64\regsvr32 C:\Windows\SysWOW64\comdlg32.ocx
```
